

Ohio State Fair Horse Show Qualifying Information

TO: Members Enrolled in Horse Projects
RE: State Fair Qualifying Shows

Dear 4-H Member,

As you are probably aware we are again using the Performance Against Standards (PAS) System for Ohio State Fair participant selection. Members will have the option to participate in the Hardin County show, set for Saturday, June 28, 9:00 a.m., and/or the Hancock County show on Tuesday, July 8, 6:00 p.m. at the Hancock County Fairgrounds.

NOTE: Please remember to review the new guidelines for state fair participation. Be sure to review the State Fair rules regarding conflicting classes. The information is available online at the following URL - <http://horse.osu.edu/4h/statefair.html>

The class registration procedure calls for us to have youth select up to 4 classes. Each member will be able to show in only those classes he/she has designated. Members must qualify in two of their designated class to be eligible for the state fair show. Members but will be allowed to ride only one horse for state fair qualifying. That horse/pony must be designated prior to the member entering the first class. Members must ride in the same four classes if showing in more than one show.

You should use the class numbers from the Hardin/Hancock County PAS Show bill when completing the registration form. **DO NOT USE THE STATE FAIR CLASS NUMBERS.** Both counties will follow the same pre-registration process. Youth will need only complete one registration form for both shows. Members should check with the entry booth when they arrive to finalize class entries.

All forms must be completed and to the Hancock County Extension office no later than June 13. We will not accept any forms after 4:30 p.m. that day. Please be sure that the forms are completed in conjunction with, and signed by the member and parent as requested. Advisors should not complete the forms for members.

We will organize the shows using the information provided on the entry forms.
