

## 621 **Ohio Birds** (State Fair Eligible)

**PROJECTS:** This project book is broken down into two sections so that it can be taken for two years. Members will learn about our feathered friends in the Buckeye State by: observing and identifying 20 different species of birds; completing activities and questions about birds; and building and using two types of bird feeders. (Federal and state laws prohibit the collection of birds, nests, eggs, etc. without a scientific collectors permit). Complete Project Guidelines listed in the front of the project book.

**JUDGING:** Judged at Miscellaneous Project Judging. Make and bring to judging a poster or educational display about something learned in the project, and a feeding station as described in the project book. Be prepared to answer questions about what was done. Bring your completed project book with you.

**FAIR:** Display the feeding station or poster in your 4-H club booth or in the miscellaneous booth in the youth building (if your club does not have a booth). Posters should be 14" x 22".

## 622 **Trapping Muskrats in Ohio** (State Fair Eligible)

**PROJECT:** Learn about muskrats and how to ethically and humanely trap them. This project is divided into two levels, and is designed for members 12-18 years old. Level 1 is for the participant who would like to learn about muskrats and trapping. Level 2 is a step-by-step guide to teach the participant how to ethically and humanely trap muskrats. Complete Project Guidelines listed in the front of the project book.

**JUDGING:** Judged at Miscellaneous Project Judging. Make an exhibit or poster of something you learned in this project. Bring your completed project book and be prepared to answer questions.

**FAIR:** Display a poster or exhibit in your 4-H club booth or in the miscellaneous booth in the youth building (if your club does not have a booth). Posters should be 14" X 22".

## 623 **Fishing for the Beginner** (State Fair Eligible)

**PROJECT:** Member will learn about Ohio fish and engage in field and stream activities. Complete the Project Guidelines listed on page 4 of the project book.

**JUDGING:** Judged at Miscellaneous Project Judging. Make a poster or exhibit as described in the project book. Bring your completed project book and be prepared to answer questions.

**FAIR:** Display poster/exhibit in your 4-H club booth or in the miscellaneous booth in the youth building (if your club does not have a booth). Posters should be 14" x 22".

## 624 **Fishing for the Intermediate** (State Fair Eligible)

**PROJECT:** Member will learn more details about fishing, equipment used, and conservation. Complete Project Guidelines listed on page 4 of the project book.

**JUDGING:** Judged at Miscellaneous Project Judging. Make a poster or exhibit as described in the project book. Bring your completed project book and be prepared to answer questions.

**FAIR:** Display poster/exhibit in your 4-H club booth or in the miscellaneous booth in the youth building (if your club does not have a booth). Posters should be 14" x 22".

## 630 **Safe Use of Guns** (State Fair Eligible)

**PROJECT:** Learn the importance of gun safety. You could save your life or the life of someone you love. This is a beginning level project for 4-H members that have an adult who can supervise their shooting. Complete Project Guidelines listed on page 3 of the project book.

**JUDGING:** Judged at Miscellaneous Project Judging. Members should bring a poster or exhibit that tells about the project. Be prepared to answer questions about the project and bring completed project book with you. **DO NOT BRING A GUN OR ANY PARTS OF A GUN TO JUDGING.**

**FAIR:** Display your poster/exhibit in your 4-H club booth or in the miscellaneous booth in the youth building (if your club does not have a booth). Posters should be 14" x 22".

## 631 **Basic Archery** (State Fair Eligible)

**PROJECT:** Aim your energy toward a sport that develops knowledge and skills in archery safety. This is a beginning level project for members who have an adult to supervise their shooting. Complete Project Guidelines listed on page 5 of the project book.

**JUDGING:** Judged at Miscellaneous Project Judging. Make a poster or exhibit of something you learned in this project. Be prepared to answer questions about the project. **DO NOT BRING BOW AND ARROWS TO JUDGING.** Bring your completed project book.

**FAIR:** Display your poster or exhibit in your 4-H club booth or in the miscellaneous booth in the youth building (if your club does not have a booth). Posters should be 14" x 22".

## 641 **Basic Beekeeping** (State Fair Eligible)

**PROJECT:** Member will learn how bees live and work, and why they are important to plants.

**JUDGING:** Judged at Miscellaneous Project Judging. Member should bring one pound of comb honey or a pint of strained honey taken from the member's hive(s). Member must make an educational exhibit dealing with the project. Be prepared to answer questions about the project and bring your completed project book with you.

**FAIR:** Member may display a comb of honey or pint of strained honey or other exhibit in their 4-H club booth or in the miscellaneous booth in the youth building (if your club does not have a booth). Posters should be 14" x 22".
