

## Wyandot County Quality Assurance

Wyandot County will accept 4-H members and their parents from outside the county to attend Quality Assurance (QA) or Pork Quality Assurance Plus.

The following arrangements must be made in order to comply:

1. Advance notice (at least 24 hours) must be given to both the Wyandot County and the resident county Extension offices. Call the Wyandot County Extension office at (419) 294-4931.
2. A photo ID must be shown at the door when registering for the Wyandot County Quality Assurance program.
  - a. The following will be acceptable forms of photo identification:
    - i. Driver's license
    - ii. Ohio ID card
    - iii. Digital photo taken by the member's Extension office and either e-mailed or printed on Extension letterhead and sent directly to the Wyandot County Extension office prior to the training
3. A \$20.00 fee, per member, must be paid at the door in order to receive credit for completing QA.

A letter will be mailed to the member's county saying the QA or PQA Plus requirements have been met.

Programs are specifically designed for ages listed, but any youth may attend at any level. Youth (who are 12 years of age and older and not a first time exhibitor) may take a test based on the appropriate skill level for their age (12 to 14 and 15 to 18) following the Quality Assurance program. A test will be conducted the last half hour of each session. Youth who pass the test will be exempt from annual Quality Assurance re-certification, in Wyandot County, until they move to the next age bracket or are no longer a junior exhibitor (19 years of age or older on December 31 of their last year).
