- A member may not give a talk or demonstration from a previous year.
- Pre-registration at hancock.osu.edu. (registration or forms) Calls will also be accepted at 419-422-3851. **Registration Deadline is June 10.**
- All work is to be original work created by the 4-H member for 4-H Club work.
- Previous clock trophy winners must enter a new class.
- Team demonstration consists of two people sharing the speaking and teaching. If different age groups, must participate in the older class.
- Easels, microphone, table, screen, laptop (PowerPoint 2010), projector and extension cord will be provided.
- No large animals may be used in the demonstration.
- Any small animal weighing less than 20 lbs. may be used; provided the public is not put at risk and all health requirements established by the Ohio Dept. of Agriculture are met. (caged or leashed prior to and following the presentation)
- Members may bring a CD or USB memory stick to use with our equipment and should have knowledge of how to install the memory stick.
- Presentations are timed. Time begins when members begin to speak and ends at the close. Time allotted for intros, questions and answers are not included.
- Members set up demonstration with no outside assistance. Jr. Leader is available if needed.
- Firearms, bows, arrows, and weapons are not permitted. Plastic replicas are permissible with caution.
- In case of computer glitch, outside technical help may be used. Members are expected to handle routine set up and use of equipment.
- If computer problem cannot be fixed quickly, a second chance may be given later. If a second failure occurs, the demonstration will end.
- Illustrated talks may not be pre-recorded.
