

The Adventure Program is 4-H Camp Ohio's most popular activity with an average minimum of 4,400 participants each year

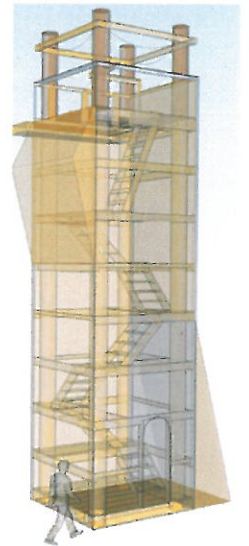


Tower Fundraiser for 4-H Camp Ohio

4-H Camp Ohio is working to raise \$75,000 in order to build a new Adventure Tower for zipping, climbing, & rappelling.

Advantages of the new tower would be:

- Roof to protect facilitators, participants & equipment
- Safer access via more functional enclosed stairway
- Improved ability to deny access to tower when not in use
- Improved equipment security between groups
- More aesthetic, challenging & realistic climbing wall with multiple climbing routes possible.
- More zip lines to enable more "zips" per hour



While this is a costly project, it will be built by a credentialed professional contractor to satisfy liability & insurance requirements. The "old" tower is still safe & functional at this time, but we are looking ahead to prepare a more serviceable tower that in order to safely enhance our Adventure programs for many years to come!
