



## Camp Guidelines/Traditions

1. Everyone participates in all camp activities. (No one is to remain in cabins when activities are scheduled.)
  2. Cell phones, devices with internet capability, Electronic games, Game Boys, DS, and lasers are not permitted at camp by counselors, CIT's or campers.
  3. When taps blow at night, lights out. No one is to leave their cabin after that time without permission of their counselor. (Bothering the counselor unnecessarily will be considered a violation of this principle.) Quiet down so you don't disturb other campers. They may be tired and want to sleep even if you don't.
  4. Smoking is prohibited in camp. (Smoking creates a fire hazard.)
  5. Firecrackers or other types of fireworks, alcohol, and drugs are prohibited in camp.
  6. Only counselors and adults (or designee) will ring the bells that signal it is time for a new activity to begin.
  7. When the person in charge raises his hand, it means everyone should become quiet immediately.
  8. Each person sits at the same table at each meal (not necessarily in the same seat).
  9. You will clean the dining hall according to the schedule. When cleaning the dining hall, do not leave until excused by the host and hostess in charge. Table hoppers will set the table for all meals.
  10. Each morning, the beds are to be made and cabins cleaned. Inspection includes the area around the cabins.
  11. No food should be in cabins; this attracts critters.
  12. You must wear shoes except in the shower or pool. Flip-flops are only permitted in the shower.
  13. Climbing on walking bridges or their trusses is not permitted.
  14. Wading is not allowed in the creek unless you are engaged in stream study or stream fishing with a staff supervisor.
  15. Bare feet, bathing suits, and hats are not permitted in the Dining Hall.
  16. Writing on cabin walls is not permitted. (\$25 fee is assessed)
  17. Respect the property of Camp Ohio.
  18. Swimming is permitted only when a lifeguard is on duty.
  19. Boys are not permitted in the girls' cabin areas; girls are not permitted in the boys' cabin areas.
  20. Campers are not permitted to leave the campgrounds at any time unless they have the approval of the camp director.
  21. No visitors are permitted in camp without the approval of the camp director.
  22. Removal of mattresses or bunks from the cabins is discouraged.
  23. Football is not to be played at camp. (Insurance doesn't cover it.)
  24. People will not be shoved off the bridge.
  24. Animals in the wildlife shelter should not be teased or handled.
