

2022 Horse Royalty Applications

Deadline to apply – June 30rd, 2022

Interviews will be held at the extension office, Monday, July 25th, 2022, from 6 to 8 p.m.

Royalty is open to any child currently a member of 4H or FFA. When filling out the application, please respond to the questions containing “4H/FFA,” with responses specific to your club or organization.

Each Candidate must complete the application, interview, a picture, and submit ONE letter of recommendation from a non-4H/non-FFA acquaintance. Application must be filled out by the Royalty Candidate. If additional space is required on the application, please attach answers on a separate sheet of paper. Everything must be completed to be considered for Royalty.

No candidate may reapply for a title they have already held, unless there are no other applicants. Repeat Candidates are encouraged to apply by June 30, 2022, deadline, but will be notified if there are other interested candidates. Crowning will take place at the Summer Series Show on August 13, 2022.

If chosen to represent the Horse Department as Royalty, your responsibilities include but are not limited to:

1. Attend official recognition of Royalty at the Hancock County Fair.
2. Help award ribbons and trophies at the fair for the Horse Department.
3. Be in attendance during the fair to represent the Horse Department.
4. Help obtain sale items for the Horse Department Auction held Monday at the fair and must be present to help with the auction.

5. A Royalty candidate MAY be asked to carry the flag at the beginning of a major fair event. Selected Royalty will be notified well in advance of the event time and place.
6. Royalty will conduct themselves in a positive, respectful manner at all times during their reign, not just during the fair.
7. Royalty is expected to wear proper attire, especially when wearing their crowns and sashes. No crop tops, revealing tank tops or shorts, and no clothing promoting violence or foul language. The Horse Department requests that Royalty try to wear their crown, hats, and sashes as much as possible. Any questions about “proper attire,” please ask the committee.
8. Cheating of any kind will not be tolerated and will result in immediate forfeit of the candidate’s position.
9. A winner and first runner up will be chosen for each position.
