

The Jason Hiser Dairy Feeder Award

- This award is for the kids who have taken a dairy feeder project for at least one year.
- This award is for the person who takes care of their own animal from the time they receive their dairy feeders until they sell their dairy feeders.
- The applicant must be in either the beef obstacle course and/or dairy feeder showmanship contest.
- The applicant also must have some experience in judging livestock.
- The applicant needs to write a paper of any length about why this award would be special to them, and tell what they have learned through the years while taking dairy feeders.
- The applicant needs to make a list of activities that they are involved in, that would have a conflict with them being with their project.
- The award is not to be given to the same person two years in a row.

The award will be presented prior to Showman of Showmen competition

1st place winner will receive a trophy and a \$100 cash award

2nd place winner will receive a \$50 cash award

Jason died in May 2000 at age 21, leaving a wife and two small sons. He was the manager of Blanchard Valley Farmers at Shawtown, and died as the result of being trapped in a grain bin.

Jason loved the fair and his dairy feeders! He was in 4-H 8 years, and FFA for 4 years. He was the first president of Rocky Ford Guys & Gals 4-H club, and served 3 years as President of his FFA chapter.
