## Denise Tebbe Memorial Scholarship Application

**Due to OSU Extension Hancock County no later than 4:30 p.m. on April 15, 2024**

- Each year two \$500 one-time scholarships will be awarded.
  - One will be awarded to a high school senior & one to a student in college.
- An individual can only receive this scholarship once.
- If needed, applicants will be asked to participate in a selection interview with members of the Hancock County 4-H Advisory Council. Recipients will be chosen on the basis of 4-H, community, and academic involvement & leadership reflected in the application questions and essays.

### Rules and Eligibility Guidelines

- Applicants must have been a Hancock County 4-H member for a minimum of three years and completed a dog or horse project.
- Applicants must be pursuing or planning to pursue a degree from an accredited two or more year post-secondary institution.
- Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.5 to apply.
- Application should be accompanied by one letter of recommendation from a responsible community member. (Person should not be related to the applicant.)
  - This letter can include information regarding the applicant's 4-H participation, skills acquired through the 4-H program (leadership, communication, etc.) and involvement in the community.
- Please attach a photo suitable for recognition as a Scholarship recipient.
- Do not attach additional pages to this application.
